- g) A copy of the last financial statement of the body applying for funding;
- h) Any criticism or published reviews;
- i) Any letters of commitment from other financial partners or third parties.

7. The awarding of a donation/funding on the part of Dulcimer Fondation pour la Musique does not in any way obligate the Foundation to renew this same kind of award in the future, nor does it imply any such right and/or entitlement.
